PUBLIC WEBSITE POLICY

This policy explains the cookies and comparable storage or access technologies used through the Ebor Trading website. It records the position verified on 18 July 2026 and distinguishes public browsing from the restricted WordPress administration area.

About this document

This policy applies to cookies, local and session storage, pixels, tags, scripts, software-development kits, device identifiers and comparable technologies. It should be read with the Website Privacy Policy. The policy is intentionally specific to the present Ebor Trading website configuration and must be reviewed before a new analytics, advertising, embedded-media or consent-management technology is deployed.

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1. Who we are

The website at <https://ebortrading.com> is operated by Ebor International Limited, trading as Ebor Trading. Ebor International Limited is registered in Hong Kong under Business Registration Number 64960969 and has its registered office at Room 912, 9/F, Lippo Sun Plaza, No. 28 Canton Road, Tsim Sha Tsui, Hong Kong. References to 'we', 'our' and 'us' mean Ebor International Limited.

2. Current website position

Current public-page position A technical review on 18 July 2026 found no cookie, local-storage item or comparable identifier intentionally set during an ordinary visit to the public homepage and no active analytics, advertising, social-media tracking, mapping or embedded-video technology. The web server still creates ordinary access and security logs; those logs are not stored on the visitor's device.

The enquiry form contains a one-time security value within the page to help validate the submission and reduce forged requests. It is not a browser cookie or persistent device identifier. The current site also serves its fonts, theme files and form scripts from the Ebor Trading domain rather than calling a third-party font or analytics service.

Because no non-essential storage or access technology is currently used on ordinary public pages, a consent banner is not required for the present configuration. This conclusion must be reassessed before the website configuration changes.

3. Applicable framework

Where cookie or technical information is personal data, the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap. 486) of Hong Kong applies to collection, use, transparency, security and retention.

For users and devices within scope of United Kingdom law, the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations 2003 as amended (PECR) govern the storing of information on, or access to information stored on, a device. The UK GDPR and Data Protection Act 2018 apply where the resulting information is personal data. The Data (Use and Access) Act 2025 introduced additional PECR exceptions for certain low-risk statistical and appearance or functionality purposes, each subject to its statutory conditions.

We use a legal exception only when all its conditions are met. A non-essential technology that does not qualify for an exception remains disabled until valid consent has been obtained.

4. What cookies and similar technologies are

A cookie is a small text file stored by a browser. A session cookie normally expires when the browser closes; a persistent cookie remains until its stated expiry or deletion. Comparable technologies include web storage, pixels, tags, scripts, device identifiers and fingerprinting techniques. The rules concern the function performed, not the technology's name.

Server-side access logs and a security value placed in the HTML of a form are not cookies because they do not store or access information on the visitor's device. They may still contain personal information and are therefore covered by the Website Privacy Policy.

5. Current public-page technology schedule

This schedule is complete for the public configuration reviewed on 18 July 2026. It does not treat a technology as authorised merely because a theme or plugin is technically capable of using it.

6. Restricted administration cookies

The following first-party WordPress cookies may be used only when an authorised user accesses or signs in to the restricted administration area. They are necessary for testing cookie support, authentication, security and administration preferences. They are not used to track ordinary public visitors for analytics or advertising.

The bracketed or braced part of a cookie name is variable and is generated from the website configuration or authorised user's identifier. WordPress permits administrators to alter some lifetimes; if the live configuration is changed, this schedule must be amended.

7. Technologies we do not currently use

- Google Analytics or another audience-measurement cookie;
- advertising, retargeting, campaign-profiling or cross-site tracking pixels;
- social-media tracking buttons or feeds that load a provider before user activation;
- embedded third-party maps or video players on the current public page;
- third-party web fonts that contact an external font provider;
- device fingerprinting for advertising or behavioural profiling; or
- a cookie-consent record, because no public non-essential technology presently requires a consent choice.

Links that take a user to an external website are not embedded technologies. Once followed, the external organisation's own privacy and cookie information applies.

8. When consent or an objection mechanism is required

If a proposed technology does not fall within a valid legal exception, it must remain disabled until the user has given freely given, specific, informed and unambiguous consent through a clear positive action. Continuing to browse, inactivity, a pre-selected option or acceptance hidden in general terms is not consent.

A future consent interface must make acceptance and rejection equally clear, provide appropriate category choices, avoid misleading design and make withdrawal as easy as consent. Necessary consent evidence may be retained to respect and demonstrate the choice.

If we rely on the PECR statistical-purpose or appearance/functionality exception, we will meet every condition, provide clear information and a simple means of objecting. Statistical output must be aggregate information that is not used to identify a person, decide matters about them or support another purpose. An exception will not be used for advertising, profiling or cross-site tracking.

9. How we will manage future changes

Before deploying a new plugin, tag, embedded service, analytics tool or marketing integration, the website administrator must identify the provider, data, purpose, category, legal position, duration, recipients, international access and available controls; test whether it activates before consent; and update this policy and any preference mechanism before publication.

A material change may require renewed consent. A scanner or provider-generated declaration may support the review but does not replace a documented configuration check.

10. First-party and third-party services

A first-party cookie is set through the Ebor Trading domain. A third-party technology is supplied by an external organisation integrated into the website. No third-party storage or tracking technology was identified on the current public page during the 18 July 2026 review.

If a third-party service is added, we will assess purpose, necessity, security, retention, international access, contractual terms, provider responsibility and whether the service can be prevented from loading before consent or user activation.

11. Information associated with website technology

Depending on a future technology and the user's choice, information could include an online identifier, Internet Protocol address, browser and device characteristics, operating system, language, approximate network-derived location, referrer, requested pages, date and time, errors and saved preferences. Any such personal information will be handled under the Website Privacy Policy.

We do not authorise a cookie to read unrelated files on a device, bypass a user's choice, or create a behavioural-advertising fingerprint.

12. Browser and device controls

Browsers and devices may permit users to delete, restrict or block cookies and web storage. These controls operate independently of the website. Blocking every cookie can prevent an authorised user from signing in to the administration area, but it does not affect the current ordinary public page because that page does not intentionally set cookies.

13. International processing

Web-server and security information may be accessible from Hong Kong, the United Kingdom or another location used by an approved hosting or security provider. Where it is personal information, the international-transfer approach in the Website Privacy Policy applies.

14. Retention and security

A session cookie expires when the session ends. A persistent administration cookie remains for the period stated in section 6 or until deletion. Web-server and security logs are normally retained for up to 12 months, with longer retention only for a documented incident, investigation or legal claim.

Controls may include HTTPS, Secure and HttpOnly attributes where appropriate, SameSite configuration, restricted administration access, multifactor authentication, least-privilege permissions, provider review, logging, updates and periodic technology scans.

15. Changes to this policy

We update this policy when the legal framework or website configuration changes. The current version and effective date will be published on the website. The technology schedules must be reviewed at least annually and before any material release.

16. Questions and complaints
